- Work collaboratively with child's learning team (e.g. parents, classroom teacher, Early Learning Director, classroom aide, other EI's, specialists etc...)
- Maintain ongoing communication with child's learning team to ensure the child's needs are being met
- Assist with classroom activities and duties if the child is functioning with immediate supports (e.g. engaged with other children and staff)

Qualifications:

- Early Childhood Certificate or equivalent, minimum Level 1 required
- Experience working with children; experience with children.
- Good communication skills
- Ability to work both independently and as part of a team
- Must be 18 years of age
- Criminal Record/Vulnerable Sector Check
- Child Intervention Check
- First Aid/CPR
